

House Bill 2069

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Revenue for Representative Nancy Nathanson)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Extends sunset for exemption of single-unit housing.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the exemption of single-unit housing; amending section 6, chapter 294, Oregon Laws
3 2017.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 6, chapter 294, Oregon Laws 2017, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 6.** (1) A city may not approve an application for exemption under ORS 307.674 on or after
7 January 1, [2025] **2032**.

8 (2) Notwithstanding the date specified in subsection (1) of this section, a qualified dwelling unit
9 of single-unit housing that was granted exemption under ORS 307.651 to 307.687 pursuant to an ap-
10 plication approved under ORS 307.674 before the date specified in subsection (1) of this section shall
11 continue to receive the exemption for the period of time for which the exemption was granted.
