

House Bill 2091

Sponsored by Representative JAVADI; Representative REYNOLDS (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Delays penalties under Health Care Cost Growth Target program until 2026.
Sunsets January 2, 2027.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to Health Care Cost Growth Target program; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority may not require a provider or payer to**
5 **undertake a performance improvement plan under ORS 442.386 (6)(c) and may not impose a**
6 **financial penalty on a provider or payer under ORS 442.386 (9), based on increases in total**
7 **health expenditures prior to January 1, 2025.**

8 **(2) The authority may require a provider or payer to undertake a performance improve-**
9 **ment plan and may impose a financial penalty on a provider or payer beginning in 2026 based**
10 **on increases in total health expenditures between 2025 and 2026 that exceed the health care**
11 **cost growth target.**

12 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**

13 **SECTION 3. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
15 **on its passage.**
