

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2100

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “funding” insert “; creating new provisions; and amending ORS
2 803.215, 803.415, 803.420, 803.570, 803.575, 805.250, 807.370, 807.410 and 822.043”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 8 and insert:

4 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 807.370 is amended to read:

5 “807.370. (1) Fees for issuance of or application for a driving privilege are as follows:

6 “(a) Class C driver license or restricted Class C driver license, [~~\$54~~] **\$58**.

7 “(b) Class C limited term driver license or restricted Class C limited term driver license, \$23.

8 “(c) Commercial driver license, whether or not the driver license contains endorsements, [~~\$75~~]
9 **\$160**.

10 “(d) Limited term commercial driver license, whether or not the driver license contains
11 endorsements, \$45.

12 “(e) Instruction driver permit, [~~\$23~~] **\$30**.

13 “(f) Commercial learner driver permit, [~~\$23~~] **\$40**.

14 “(g) Limited term commercial learner driver permit, \$23.

15 “(h) Special student driver permit, \$23.

16 “(i) Emergency driver permit, \$23.

17 “(j) Special limited vision condition learner’s permit, \$13.

18 “(k) Disability golf cart driver permit, \$44.

19 “(L) Hardship driver permit application, [~~\$50~~] **\$75**.

20 “(2) In addition to paying a fee under this section for issuance of a commercial driver license
21 of any class, when the Department of Transportation accepts skills test results from a driver com-
22 petency tester certified under ORS 807.080, the person shall pay a fee of \$40.

23 “(3) Fees for a motorcycle endorsement are as follows:

24 “(a) In addition to any fee for the endorsed driver license, for an original motorcycle endorse-
25 ment added at the time of an original issuance of a driving privilege or with a renewal or replace-
26 ment of an existing driving privilege, [~~\$46~~] **\$60**.

27 “(b) For an original motorcycle endorsement added without an original issuance of a driving
28 privilege or without a renewal or replacement of an existing driving privilege, [~~\$49~~] **\$60**.

29 “(c) A Motorcycle Safety Subaccount fee:

30 “(A) Upon original issuance of a motorcycle endorsement, \$38.

31 “(B) Upon renewal of a driver license with a motorcycle endorsement, \$28.

32 “(4) Fees for a farm endorsement are as follows:

33 “(a) In addition to any fee for the endorsed driver license, for an original farm endorsement
34 added at the time of an original issuance of a driving privilege or with a renewal or replacement
35 of an existing driving privilege, \$26.

1 “(b) For an original farm endorsement added without an original issuance of a driving privilege
2 or without a renewal or replacement of an existing driving privilege, \$29.

3 “(5) Fees for renewal of a driving privilege are as follows:

4 “(a) Class C driver license, [~~\$34~~] **\$48**.

5 “(b) Class C limited term driver license, \$8.

6 “(c) Commercial driver license, [~~\$55~~] **\$98**.

7 “(d) Limited term commercial driver license, \$14.

8 “(e) Instruction driver permit, [~~\$23~~] **\$26**.

9 “(f) Disability golf cart driver permit, \$32.

10 “(6) Fee to replace a driver license or driver permit, [~~\$26~~] **\$30**.

11 “(7) Fees to take tests required for driving privileges or to remove restrictions are as follows:

12 “(a) The knowledge test for a Class C driver license or Class C limited term driver license,
13 [~~\$5~~] **\$7**.

14 “(b) The knowledge test for a motorcycle endorsement, [~~\$5~~] **\$7**.

15 “(c) The knowledge test for any commercial driver license or commercial learner driver permit,
16 to remove a commercial driving privilege restriction or to add a commercial driving privilege
17 endorsement, \$10.

18 “(d) The skills test for a Class C driver license or Class C limited term driver license, [~~\$9~~] **\$45**.

19 “(e) The skills test for any commercial driver license, to remove a restriction or to add any
20 commercial driver license endorsement, [~~\$70~~] **\$145**.

21 “(8) Student Driver Training Fund eligibility fee, \$6.

22 “(9) Limited term Student Driver Training Fund eligibility fee, \$2.

23 “(10) Fee for reinstatement of revoked driving privileges under ORS 809.390 or reinstatement
24 of suspended driving privileges under ORS 809.380, [~~\$75~~] **\$85**.

25 “(11) The department may adopt rules to provide for the assessment or retention of the skills
26 test fee when a test is scheduled but the applicant fails to appear at the scheduled time.

27 “**SECTION 2.** ORS 807.410 is amended to read:

28 “807.410. (1) The following fees apply to identification cards unless otherwise provided by ORS
29 807.400 or otherwise provided by law:

30 “(a) For issuance of an original identification card, [~~\$44.50~~] **\$47**.

31 “(b) For renewal of an identification card, [~~\$40.50~~] **\$43**.

32 “(c) For replacement of an identification card, [~~\$39.50~~] **\$40**.

33 “(d) For reinstatement of an identification card after suspension, [~~\$75~~] **\$85**.

34 “(e) For issuance of an original limited term identification card, \$20.

35 “(f) For renewal of a limited term identification card, \$18.

36 “(g) For replacement of a limited term identification card, [~~\$39.50~~] **\$40**.

37 “(2) The Department of Transportation may not charge a fee for issuing, renewing or replacing
38 a parking identification card.

39 “(3) The department may not charge a fee for issuing or renewing an identification card, or
40 providing two replacement identification cards before the expiration of the current identification
41 card, for an individual who is experiencing homelessness. The individual shall present a form that
42 indicates the individual qualifies for the fee waiver, as determined by a nonprofit organization **or**
43 **state agency** that provides services to individuals experiencing homelessness. Before a nonprofit
44 organization **or state agency** issues documentation under this subsection, the organization **or state**
45 **agency** must first meet the standards established by the department by rule. The department, by

1 rule, shall prescribe the form.

2 “(4) As used in this section, ‘state agency’ means an agency of the executive department,
3 as defined in ORS 174.112.

4 “SECTION 3. ORS 803.215 is amended to read:

5 “803.215. A fee of [~~\$7~~] **\$9** shall be charged for an inspection of a vehicle required by ORS
6 803.210.

7 “SECTION 4. ORS 803.420 is amended to read:

8 “803.420. (1) The vehicle registration fees imposed under this section shall be based on the
9 classifications determined by the Department of Transportation by rule. The department may classify
10 a vehicle to ensure that registration fees for the vehicle are the same as for other vehicles the de-
11 partment determines to be comparable.

12 “(2) Except as otherwise provided in this section, or unless the vehicle is registered quarterly,
13 the fees described in this section are for an entire registration period for the vehicle as described
14 under ORS 803.415. For a vehicle registered for a quarterly registration period under ORS 803.415,
15 the department shall apportion any fee under this section to reflect the number of quarters regis-
16 tered.

17 “(3) Vehicle registration fees are due when a vehicle is registered and when the registered
18 owner renews the registration.

19 “(4) In addition to the registration fees listed in this section, a county or a district may impose
20 an additional registration fee as provided under ORS 801.041 and 801.042.

21 “(5) A rental or leasing company, as defined in ORS 221.275, that elects to initially register a
22 vehicle for an annual or biennial registration period shall pay a fee of \$2 in addition to the vehicle
23 registration fee provided under this section.

24 “(6) The registration fees for each year of the registration period for vehicles subject to biennial
25 registration are as follows:

26 “(a) Passenger vehicles not otherwise provided for in this section or ORS 821.320, \$43.

27 “(b) Utility trailers or light trailers, as those terms are defined by rule by the department, \$63.

28 “(c) Mopeds and motorcycles, \$44.

29 “(d) Low-speed vehicles, \$63.

30 “(e) Medium-speed electric vehicles, \$63.

31 “(7) The registration fees for vehicles that are subject to biennial registration and that are listed
32 in this subsection are as follows:

33 “(a) State-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.045 and undercover vehicles registered un-
34 der ORS 805.060, \$10 upon registration or renewal.

35 “(b) Fixed load vehicles:

36 “(A) If a declaration of weight described under ORS 803.435 is submitted establishing the weight
37 of the vehicle at 3,000 pounds or less, \$61.

38 “(B) If no declaration of weight is submitted or if the weight of the vehicles is in excess of 3,000
39 pounds, \$82.

40 “(c) Travel trailers, special use trailers, campers and motor homes, based on length as deter-
41 mined under ORS 803.425:

42 “(A) Trailers or campers that are 6 to 10 feet in length, \$81.

43 “(B) Trailers or campers over 10 feet in length, \$81 plus [~~\$6.75~~] **\$7** a foot for each foot of length
44 over the first 10 feet.

45 “(C) Motor homes that are 6 to 14 feet in length, \$86.

1 “(D) Motor homes over 14 feet in length, \$126 plus [~~\$7.50~~] **\$8** a foot for each foot of length over
2 the first 10 feet.

3 “(8) The registration fee for trailers for hire that are equipped with pneumatic tires made of an
4 elastic material and that are not travel trailers or trailers registered under permanent registration
5 is \$30.

6 “(9) The registration fees for vehicles subject to ownership registration are as follows:

7 “(a) Government-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.040, \$5.

8 “(b) Vehicles registered with special registration for disabled veterans under ORS 805.100 or for
9 former prisoners of war under ORS 805.110, \$15.

10 “(c) School vehicles registered under ORS 805.050, \$5.

11 “(10) The registration fees for vehicles subject to permanent registration are as follows:

12 “(a) Antique vehicles registered under ORS 805.010, \$100.

13 “(b) Vehicles of special interest registered under ORS 805.020, \$100.

14 “(c) Racing activity vehicles registered under ORS 805.035, \$100.

15 “(d) Trailers, \$10.

16 “(e) State-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.045 and undercover vehicles registered un-
17 der ORS 805.060, \$10.

18 “(11) The registration fee for trailers registered as part of a fleet under an agreement reached
19 pursuant to ORS 802.500 is the same fee as the fee for vehicles of the same type registered under
20 other provisions of the Oregon Vehicle Code.

21 “(12) The registration fee for vehicles with proportional registration under ORS 826.009, or
22 proportional fleet registration under ORS 826.011, is the same fee as the fee for vehicles of the same
23 type under this section except that the fees shall be fixed on an apportioned basis as provided under
24 the agreement established under ORS 826.007.

25 “(13) In addition to any other registration fees charged for registration of vehicles in fleets un-
26 der ORS 805.120, the department may charge the following fees:

27 “(a) Service charge for each vehicle entered into a fleet, \$3.

28 “(b) Service charge for each vehicle in the fleet at the time of renewal, \$2.

29 “(14)(a) The registration fee for motor vehicles required to establish a registration weight under
30 ORS 803.430 or 826.013, tow vehicles used to transport property for hire other than as described in
31 ORS 822.210 and commercial buses is as provided in the following chart, based upon the weight
32 submitted in the declaration of weight prepared under ORS 803.435 or 826.015:

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23 “(C) The owner of a vehicle described in subparagraph (A) or (B) of this paragraph must certify
 24 at the time of initial registration, in a manner determined by the department by rule, that the motor
 25 vehicle will be used exclusively to transport manufactured structures or exclusively as described in
 26 ORS 822.210, unless the motor vehicle is registered under paragraph (a) of this subsection, or as
 27 described in ORS 825.015 or 825.017 (13). Registration of a vehicle described in subparagraph (A) or
 28 (B) of this paragraph is invalid if the vehicle is operated in any manner other than that described
 29 in the certification under this subparagraph.

30 “(c) Subject to paragraph (d) of this subsection, the registration fee for motor vehicles registered
 31 as farm vehicles under ORS 805.300 is as provided in the following chart, based upon the registra-
 32 tion weight given in the declaration of weight submitted under ORS 803.435:

43 “(d) For any vehicle that is registered under a quarterly registration period, the registration fee
44 is a minimum of \$15 for each quarter registered plus an additional fee of \$2.

45 “(15) The registration and renewal fees for vehicles specified in this subsection that are required

1 to establish a registration weight under ORS 803.430 or 826.013 are as follows:

2 “(a) State-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.045, \$10.

3 “(b) Undercover vehicles registered under ORS 805.060, \$10.

4 “**SECTION 5.** ORS 803.570 is amended to read:

5 “803.570. Except as otherwise specifically provided by law, the Department of Transportation
6 shall collect the fee described by this section each time the department issues a registration plate
7 upon the registration of a vehicle or at other times when a registration plate is issued by the de-
8 partment. The following all apply to the fee established by this section:

9 “(1) The fee shall be in addition to any other fee collected upon issuance of a registration plate.

10 “(2) The fee for each registration plate issued and for each pair of plates issued shall be deter-
11 mined by the department and shall be established by the department by rule. The department shall
12 establish fees for a single plate and for a pair of plates under this section by:

13 “(a) Determining the cost of manufacturing a single plate or a pair of plates and rounding the
14 cost to the next higher [*half-dollar*] **dollar**; and

15 “(b) Adding \$10 for a single plate and \$20 for a pair of plates.

16 “**SECTION 6.** ORS 803.575 is amended to read:

17 “803.575. (1) The fee for issuance of a duplicate or replacement registration card under ORS
18 803.510 is \$5.

19 “(2) The fee for issuance of a replacement or duplicate registration plate under ORS 803.530 is
20 the fee established under ORS 803.570, together with a fee of **\$12** [*\$5 if the plate is issued at the time*
21 *of renewal of registration or a fee of \$10 if the plate is issued at any other time*].

22 “(3) The fee for transfer of registration plate under ORS 803.530 is [*\$6*] **\$30**.

23 “(4) The fee for issuance of replacement registration stickers under ORS 803.555 is \$10.

24 “(5) The fee for issuance of both replacement or duplicate registration plates and replacement
25 registration stickers, when issued at the same time, is the fee established under ORS 803.570, to-
26 gether with a fee of **\$12** [*\$5 if the plate and stickers are issued at the time of renewal of registration*
27 *or a fee of \$10 if the plate and stickers are issued at any other time*].

28 “(6) A fee paid under subsection (2), (4) or (5) of this section includes the cost of any duplicate
29 or replacement registration card issued.

30 “**SECTION 7.** ORS 805.250 is amended to read:

31 “805.250. This section establishes fees for issuance of registration plates authorized under ORS
32 805.200. If a fee for plates authorized in ORS 805.200 is not established in this section, the fee is the
33 same fee as established under ORS 803.570. Where a fee is established under this section, the fee
34 is in addition to the fee established under ORS 803.570 unless otherwise provided in the following:

35 “(1) Amateur radio operator registration plates issued under ORS 805.230, \$5.

36 “(2) Customized registration plates issued under ORS 805.240:

37 “(a) For original issuance or renewal, \$50 annual fee.

38 “(b) For issuance of a duplicate or replacement plate, **\$12** [*\$5 when the plate is issued at the time*
39 *of renewal of registration or \$10 when the plate is issued at any other time*].

40 “(3) Special interest registration plates approved under ORS 805.210 are approved without cost
41 except as provided in this subsection, including without payment of the fee established under ORS
42 803.570. If identifying stickers are required, \$1 per sticker or pair of stickers.

43 “(4) Dealer plates issued under ORS 822.020 and 822.040 are as follows:

44 “(a) For the original dealer plate, no fee except the fee established under ORS 803.570.

45 “(b) For replacement dealer plates, \$10 for each plate except that persons dealing exclusively

1 in motorcycles, mopeds, snowmobiles or any combination of those vehicles shall pay only \$3 for each
2 replacement plate.

3 “(c) For additional plates, or for renewal of registration, \$42, except that persons dealing ex-
4 clusively in motorcycles, mopeds or snowmobiles or any combination of those vehicles shall pay only
5 \$9 for each additional plate, or for renewal of registration.

6 “(5) Special vehicle transporter plates or devices issued under ORS 822.310, \$5 for each plate
7 or device.

8 “**SECTION 8.** ORS 803.415 is amended to read:

9 “803.415. This section establishes registration periods for vehicles. The registration periods are
10 periods described under ORS 803.400. Except as provided in the following, the registration period for
11 any vehicle registered in this state by the Department of Transportation is a biennial registration
12 period:

13 “(1) The following vehicles have permanent registration:

14 “(a) Antique vehicles registered under ORS 805.010.

15 “(b) Vehicles of special interest registered under ORS 805.020.

16 “(c) Trailers that will be operated on the highways at a loaded weight of more than 8,000 pounds
17 and are not travel trailers, fixed load vehicles or special use trailers.

18 “(2) Government-owned vehicles registered under ORS 805.040 have ownership registration.

19 “(3) The following vehicles may be registered under annual or quarterly registration unless the
20 vehicles are registered under proportional registration under ORS 826.009 or proportional fleet
21 registration under ORS 826.011:

22 “(a) Vehicles required to establish a registration weight under ORS 803.430.

23 “(b) Commercial buses.

24 “(c) Vehicles registered as farm vehicles under ORS 805.300.

25 “(4) Snowmobiles are registered as provided in ORS 821.080.

26 “(5) Vehicles operated by dealers who hold certificates under ORS 822.020 are as provided under
27 ORS 822.040.

28 “(6) Trailers for hire that will be operated at a loaded weight of 8,000 pounds or less may be
29 registered as follows:

30 “(a) Annual registration; or

31 “(b) If registered under an agreement pursuant to ORS 802.500, for a period of time determined
32 as specified in the agreement or as determined by the department.

33 “(7) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (10) of this section, the registration period for
34 electric vehicles and hybrid vehicles that use electricity and another source of motive power is a
35 biennial registration period except that the registration period for the following electric or hybrid
36 vehicles is an annual registration period:

37 “(a) Commercial buses.

38 “(b) Electric or hybrid vehicles registered as farm vehicles under ORS 805.300.

39 “(c) Vehicles required to establish registration weight under ORS 803.430.

40 “(8) Vehicles registered under ORS 805.100 have an ownership registration period.

41 “(9) School vehicles registered under ORS 805.050 have ownership registration except that the
42 registration shall continue to be valid if ownership of the vehicle is transferred to a person who
43 continues to use the vehicle for purposes authorized by ORS 805.050.

44 “(10) The following vehicles have a four-year registration period:

45 “(a) New vehicles registered under ORS 803.420 (6)(a) for which new registration plates will be

1 issued; **and**

2 “[*(b) New mopeds or motorcycles registered under ORS 803.420 (6)(c) for which new registration*

3 *plates will be issued; and*]

4 “[*(c)*] **(b)** New trailers registered under ORS 803.420 (6)(b), for which new registration plates will

5 be issued.

6 “(11) A rental or leasing company, as defined in ORS 221.275, may elect an annual, a biennial

7 or a four-year registration period for the initial registration of a new vehicle registered under ORS

8 803.420 (6)(a) for which new registration plates will be issued if the company owns the vehicle that

9 is being registered. The subsequent renewal or reregistration periods for the vehicle are biennial.

10 “(12) Vehicles registered under ORS 805.110 have ownership registration except that the regis-

11 tration shall continue to be valid if ownership of the vehicle is transferred to a spouse who is au-

12 thorized to retain the former prisoner of war registration plates under ORS 805.110.

13 “**SECTION 9.** ORS 822.043 is amended to read:

14 “822.043. (1) As used in this section:

15 “(a) ‘Integrator’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 802.600.

16 “(b) ‘Vehicle dealer’ means a person issued a vehicle dealer certificate under ORS 822.020.

17 “(2) A vehicle dealer that the Department of Transportation has designated to act as an agent

18 of the department under ORS 802.031 may elect to prepare, submit, or prepare and submit documents

19 necessary to:

20 “(a) Issue or transfer a certificate of title for a vehicle;

21 “(b) Register a vehicle or transfer registration of a vehicle;

22 “(c) Issue a registration plate;

23 “(d) Verify and clear a title;

24 “(e) Perfect, release or satisfy a lien or other security interest;

25 “(f) Comply with federal security requirements; or

26 “(g) Render any other services for the purpose of complying with state and federal laws related

27 to the sale of a vehicle.

28 “(3) A vehicle dealer who prepares any documents described in subsection (2) of this section:

29 “(a) May charge a purchaser of a vehicle a document processing fee for the preparation of those

30 documents.

31 “(b) May not charge a purchaser of a vehicle a document processing fee for the submission of

32 any document or the issuance of a registration plate.

33 “(c) May charge a purchaser of a vehicle a document processing fee for performing any of the

34 services described in subsection (2) of this section in connection with preparing the documents de-

35 scribed in subsection (2) of this section.

36 “(4) A purchaser of a vehicle may negotiate the amount of the document processing fee with a

37 vehicle dealer, but in no case shall the document processing fee charged by a vehicle dealer under

38 this section exceed:

39 “(a) [~~\$150~~] **\$250**, if the vehicle dealer uses an integrator; or

40 “(b) [~~\$115~~] **\$200**, if the vehicle dealer does not use an integrator.

41 “(5) If a vehicle dealer charges a document processing fee under subsection (4)(a) of this section,

42 of the amount collected [~~\$25~~] **\$35** shall be paid to the integrator.

43 “(6) Unless otherwise provided by rule, if a vehicle dealer uses an integrator and charges a

44 document processing fee greater than that charged for not using an integrator, the dealer must in-

45 form the purchaser of the vehicle of the option of using an integrator to prepare the documents. The

1 purchaser may then elect whether or not to have the vehicle dealer use an integrator to prepare the
2 documents.

3 “(7) If the purchaser of a vehicle pays a document processing fee, the vehicle dealer shall pre-
4 pare and submit all documents to complete the transaction as permitted by law.

5 “(8)(a) A vehicle dealer who collects the privilege tax imposed under ORS 320.405 from the
6 purchaser of a taxable motor vehicle may collect the privilege tax at the same time and in the same
7 manner as the vehicle dealer collects document processing fees under this section. The amount of
8 the privilege tax shall be in addition to and not in lieu of document processing fees collected under
9 this section.

10 “(b) A vehicle dealer may exclude the amount of the privilege tax from the capitalized cost and
11 offering price of a taxable motor vehicle as those terms are defined by the Department of Justice
12 by rule.

13 “**SECTION 10.** (1) **The amendments to ORS 803.215, 803.420, 803.570, 803.575, 805.250,**
14 **807.370 and 807.410 by sections 1 to 7 of this 2023 Act apply to amounts imposed on or after**
15 **the effective date of this 2023 Act.**

16 “(2) **The amendments to ORS 803.415 by section 8 of this 2023 Act apply to new mopeds**
17 **or motorcycles registered on or after the effective date of this 2023 Act.**

18 “**SECTION 11.** **The amendments to ORS 822.043 by section 9 of this 2023 Act apply to fees**
19 **imposed on or after the effective date of this 2023 Act.”.**

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
