

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2101

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “highways;” delete the rest of the line and insert “and
2 declaring an emergency.”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) Each year, the Department of Transportation shall determine the
5 amount of funding allocated under ORS 367.095 (4)(b) that is necessary to fund:**

6 **“(a) Transportation projects specified by the Legislative Assembly by law;**

7 **“(b) The matching moneys needed to spend federal funds;**

8 **“(c) Highway maintenance activities;**

9 **“(d) Programs that are more efficient to operate using state moneys; and**

10 **“(e) Other purposes for which federal funds cannot be used.**

11 **“(2) From state moneys described under ORS 367.095 (4)(b) remaining after setting aside
12 the funds necessary to meet the purposes described in subsection (1) of this section, the de-
13 partment shall allocate to local governments \$35 million per year.**

14 **“(3) The department shall replace any state funds made available to local governments
15 under subsection (2) of this section with federal surface transportation funding on a dollar
16 for dollar basis.**

17 **“(4)(a) The department shall allocate the state moneys described in ORS 367.095 (4)(b)
18 under subsection (2) of this section to the following:**

19 **“(A) Counties;**

20 **“(B) Cities with a population of 5,000 or more and located outside the boundaries of a
21 metropolitan planning organization, as defined in ORS 197.629;**

22 **“(C) Metropolitan planning organizations in urbanized areas with a population of less
23 than 200,000;**

24 **“(D) The League of Oregon Cities; or**

25 **“(E) The Association of Oregon Counties.**

26 **“(b) Moneys allocated under this subsection shall be used solely for uses that are con-
27 sistent with Article IX, section 3a, of the Oregon Constitution.**

28 **“(c) The distribution of moneys under this subsection shall be:**

29 **“(A) Determined by agreement between the department, the League of Oregon Cities and
30 the Association of Oregon Counties; and**

31 **“(B) Provided to recipients through guidelines developed by the department.**

32 **“(5) If less than \$35 million of state moneys is allocated to local governments under
33 subsection (2) of this section in a year, the department shall, to the extent possible, allocate,
34 under subsection (4) of this section, federal surface transportation funding in an amount
35 equal to the difference between \$35 million and the amount of state moneys allocated to local**

1 **governments under subsection (2) of this section.**

2 **“(6) The department may adopt rules to carry out the provisions of this section.**

3 **“SECTION 2. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
4 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
5 **on its passage.”.**

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
