## House Bill 2106

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Secretary of State to study how best to ensure transparency through reporting of campaign contributions and independent expenditures. Directs secretary to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to campaign finance not later than September 15, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to campaign finance. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall study how best to ensure transparency through 4 the reporting of campaign contributions and independent expenditures. The secretary shall 5 submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192,245, and may include recommendations 6 for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to campaign finance no later than September 15, 2024. 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025. 9
