## House Bill 2123

Sponsored by Representative MANNIX (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Provides that county court or board of county commissioners has authority to fill vacancy in office of district attorney, rather than Governor.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to district attorneys; amending ORS 8.640. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 **SECTION 1.** ORS 8.640 is amended to read: 4 8.640. When a vacancy occurs in the office of district attorney, the [Governor] county court 5 or board of county commissioners for the county in which the district attorney is elected 6 must appoint some suitable person to fill the vacancy until the next election and qualification of a 7 8 successor at the next general election. A person appointed to fill a vacancy in the office must qualify in the same manner as a person elected thereto, and shall have like power and compensation, and perform the same duties. 10 11
