SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to establish training program for deputy district attorneys.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to training of deputy district attorneys.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training shall establish
5	a training program for deputy district attorneys. The training program may not exceed 30
6	days in length and must include training on trauma-informed victim advocacy.
7	(2) The department shall allow each district attorney to enroll one deputy district attor-
8	ney in the program each year. The department may allow a district attorney to enroll more
9	than one deputy district attorney in the program each year.
10	(3) The state shall reimburse the county for any costs incurred in enrolling a deputy
11	district attorney in the program.
