

House Bill 2134

Sponsored by Representative MANNIX (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to establish training program for deputy district attorneys.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to training of deputy district attorneys.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training shall establish**
5 **a training program for deputy district attorneys. The training program may not exceed 30**
6 **days in length and must include training on trauma-informed victim advocacy.**

7 **(2) The department shall allow each district attorney to enroll one deputy district attor-**
8 **ney in the program each year. The department may allow a district attorney to enroll more**
9 **than one deputy district attorney in the program each year.**

10 **(3) The state shall reimburse the county for any costs incurred in enrolling a deputy**
11 **district attorney in the program.**
