

House Bill 2255

Sponsored by Representative MANNIX (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes Governor to cancel or revoke parole granted by State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the authority of the Governor; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 144.**

5 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Governor may cancel or**
6 **revoke the parole granted to any convicted person by the State Board of Parole and Post-**
7 **Prison Supervision under this chapter or after a hearing described in ORS 163.105, 163.107,**
8 **163.115 or 163.155. A written order of the Governor canceling or revoking parole has the same**
9 **force and effect and shall be executed in the same manner as an order of the board.**

10 **SECTION 3. This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2023**
11 **regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
