SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Directs Department of Corrections to study programs available to adults in custody, and to provide results of study to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2024.]
[Sunsets January 2, 2025.]

Requires Department of Corrections to establish, maintain and publish publicly accessible data dashboard on department's website.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to adults in custody.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Corrections shall establish, maintain and publish on the**
5 **department's website a publicly accessible data dashboard detailing the following informa-**
6 **tion:**

7 (1) **The race, age and misconduct status of each adult in custody placed in a disciplinary**
8 **segregation unit.**

9 (2) **The duration for which each adult in custody placed in a disciplinary segregation unit**
10 **stays in the disciplinary segregation unit.**

11 (3) **The duration for which each adult in custody, after completing a placement in a disci-**
12 **plinary segregation unit, remains in the general population before returning to a discipli-**
13 **nary segregation unit.**

14 (4) **The level of misconduct providing the basis for the adult in custody to return to the**
15 **disciplinary segregation unit under subsection (3) of this section.**

16 (5) **The amount of time, in the aggregate and for each occasion, that an adult in custody**
17 **placed in a disciplinary segregation unit is allowed to spend outside of a cell.**

18 **SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2023 Act becomes operative on February 1, 2024.**

19 (2) **The Department of Corrections shall take any action before the operative date speci-**
20 **fied in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the department to exercise,**
21 **on or after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties,**
22 **functions and powers conferred on the department by section 1 of this 2023 Act.**
