CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to adults in custody.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Department of Corrections shall establish, maintain and publish on the department's website a publicly accessible data dashboard detailing the following information:

(1) The race, age and misconduct status of each adult in custody placed in a disciplinary segregation unit.

(2) The duration for which each adult in custody placed in a disciplinary segregation unit stays in the disciplinary segregation unit.

(3) The duration for which each adult in custody, after completing a placement in a disciplinary segregation unit, remains in the general population before returning to a disciplinary segregation unit.

(4) The level of misconduct providing the basis for the adult in custody to return to the disciplinary segregation unit under subsection (3) of this section.

(5) The amount of time, in the aggregate and for each occasion, that an adult in custody placed in a disciplinary segregation unit is allowed to spend outside of a cell.

SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2023 Act becomes operative on February 1, 2024.

(2) The Department of Corrections shall take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the department to exercise, on or after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department by section 1 of this 2023 Act.
