House Bill 2393

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to determine how to best address food insecurity for students enrolled in post-secondary institutions of education in this state. Directs commission to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to higher education not later than September 15, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to post-secondary student food insecurity. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall conduct a study to 4 5 determine how to best address food insecurity for students enrolled in post-secondary insti-6 tutions of education in this state. The commission shall submit a report in the manner pro-7 vided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim 8 committees of the Legislative Assembly related to higher education no later than September 9 15, 2024. 10 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
