

House Bill 2446

Sponsored by Representative NOSSE (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires extension to no later than December 31, 2026, of term for contract between Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organization.

Sunsets January 2, 2027.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to coordinated care organization contracts; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 414.590 (2)(a), a contract entered into between the**
5 **Oregon Health Authority and a coordinated care organization under ORS 414.572 (1) that is**
6 **in effect on the effective date of this 2023 Act shall be extended to no later than December**
7 **31, 2026.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
