On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "creating new provisions; amending ORS 692.375;". 1 2 In line 6, after "not" insert "knowingly". 3 Delete lines 20 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert: "SECTION 3. (1) The estate of a decedent whose remains are displayed in violation of 4 5 section 2 of this 2023 Act may bring a civil action for injunctive relief, damages or other appropriate relief against any person whose conduct in connection with the display is un-6 lawful under section 2 of this 2023 Act. 7 "(2) Upon prevailing in an action brought under this section, the plaintiff may recover: 8 9 "(a) Both special and general damages, including damages for emotional distress; and 10 "(b) Punitive damages. 11 "(3)(a) The court shall award reasonable attorney fees to the prevailing plaintiff in an 12action brought under this section. 13"(b) The court may award reasonable attorney fees and expert witness fees incurred by 14 a defendant who prevails in the action if the court determines that the plaintiff had no ob-15jectively reasonable basis for asserting a claim or no reasonable basis for appealing an ad-16 verse decision of a trial court. "SECTION 4. Sections 2 and 3 of this 2023 Act apply to conduct occurring on or after the 17 18 effective date of this 2023 Act. 19 "SECTION 5. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 20 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect 21on its passage.".
