HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2574

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 13 and insert:
2	"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, 'hospital' has the meaning given that term in
3	ORS 442.015, excluding special inpatient care facilities as defined by the Oregon Health Au
4	thority by rule.
5	"(2) A hospital licensed under ORS 441.025 must:
6	"(a) Adopt a policy for the dispensing of human immunodeficiency virus post-exposure
7	prophylaxis drugs or therapies; and
8	"(b) Have procedures in place to ensure that hospital staff dispense to a patient, with a
9	patient's informed consent, at least a five-day supply of human immunodeficiency virus
10	post-exposure prophylactic drugs or therapies following the patient's possible exposure to
11	human immunodeficiency virus, unless medically contraindicated.
12	"(3) The hospital policy adopted under this section must in all respects, other than as
13	specified in subsection (2) of this section, conform to guidelines issued by the Centers for
14	Disease Control and Prevention.".
15	Delete lines 17 through 24 and insert:
16	"(2) Once each calendar year, the Oregon Health Authority shall provide to each type A hospi
17	tal and to each type B hospital in this state, at no cost to the hospital, one 30-day supply of human
18	immunodeficiency virus post-exposure prophylactic drugs or therapies, unless declined by the hospi
19	tal.".
20	On page 2, delete line 9 and insert:
21	"(c) Subject to ORS 742.008, require a deductible, copayment, coinsurance or other cost-sharing
22	for the coverage of".

In line 10, delete "supplies of".

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
