CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to fees for educator preparation providers; creating new provisions; amending section 5, chapter 647, Oregon Laws 2021; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 5, chapter 647, Oregon Laws 2021, is amended to read:

Sec. 5. The amendments to ORS 342.127 by section 4 [of this 2021 Act], chapter 647, Oregon Laws 2021, become operative on [January 1, 2026] the effective date of this 2023 Act.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect on its passage.
