In line 14, restore "five" and delete "six". 12In line 19, delete the comma and insert "or" and delete "or retired status". 13 Delete lines 26 and 27 and insert: 14 "(C) Is not a current licensee, if the board member was appointed to serve on the board as a 15 licensee.". 16 17 Delete lines 31 through 45 and insert: 18 "SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, nothing in the amendments to ORS 677.235 by section 1 of this 2023 Act affects the term of office of any 19 20 member of the Oregon Medical Board appointed prior to and serving on the operative date 21specified in section 3 of this 2023 Act. However, as vacancies occur, appointments shall be made in accordance with the qualifications specified in ORS 677.235, as amended by section 22231 of this 2023 Act. 24"(2) The term of an emeritus board member expires on the operative date specified in section 3 of this 2023 Act.". 2526On page 3, line 1, delete "(1)". 27Delete lines 3 through 7.
