

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2627

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 6, restore “14” and delete “16”.
- 2 In line 9, delete “Seven” and insert “Six”.
- 3 Delete lines 12 and 13 and insert:
- 4 “(d) Two must be physician assistants licensed under ORS 677.512; and”.
- 5 Delete lines 27 through 30 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 5 and insert:
- 6 “(D) The board members required to be physician assistants licensed under ORS 677.512 may
- 7 be selected by the Governor from a list of three to five candidates for each member described in
- 8 subsection (1)(d) of this section whose term expires in that year, submitted by the Oregon Society
- 9 of Physician Assistants not later than February 1.
- 10 “(b) Members who are physicians must have been in the active practice of their profession for
- 11 at least five years immediately preceding their appointment.”.
- 12 In line 14, restore “five” and delete “six”.
- 13 In line 19, delete the comma and insert “or” and delete “or retired status”.
- 14 Delete lines 26 and 27 and insert:
- 15 “(C) Is not a current licensee, if the board member was appointed to serve on the board as a
- 16 licensee.”.
- 17 Delete lines 31 through 45 and insert:
- 18 **“SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, nothing in the**
- 19 **amendments to ORS 677.235 by section 1 of this 2023 Act affects the term of office of any**
- 20 **member of the Oregon Medical Board appointed prior to and serving on the operative date**
- 21 **specified in section 3 of this 2023 Act. However, as vacancies occur, appointments shall be**
- 22 **made in accordance with the qualifications specified in ORS 677.235, as amended by section**
- 23 **1 of this 2023 Act.**
- 24 **“(2) The term of an emeritus board member expires on the operative date specified in**
- 25 **section 3 of this 2023 Act.”.**
- 26 On page 3, line 1, delete “(1)”.
- 27 Delete lines 3 through 7.
