

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2683

1 On page 4 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 33, insert:

2 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation  
3 made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (8), chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws  
4 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for the Oregon El-  
5 igibility Partnership, is increased by \$313,407, for information technology changes required  
6 to carry out the provisions of this 2023 Act.

7 “**SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
8 expenditures established by section 2 (9), chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House  
9 Bill 5026), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-  
10 penses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare  
11 receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental  
12 Security Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery  
13 funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2023 (En-  
14 rolled House Bill 5026), collected or received by the Department of Human Services, for the  
15 Oregon Eligibility Partnership, is increased by \$1,830,240, for information technology system  
16 changes required to carry out the provisions of this 2023 Act.

17 “**SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
18 expenditures established by section 3 (8), chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House  
19 Bill 5026), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-  
20 penses from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter \_\_\_\_\_,  
21 Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), collected or received by the Department of  
22 Human Services, for the Oregon Eligibility Partnership, is increased by \$313,406, for infor-  
23 mation technology system changes required to carry out the provisions of this 2023 Act.

24 “**SECTION 7.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-  
25 priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the  
26 General Fund, the amount of \$7,843, to support position costs related to system updates re-  
27 quired to carry out the provisions of this 2023 Act.

28 “**SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
29 \$626,811 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for  
30 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,  
31 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Health  
32 Authority, for the Office of Information Services, to support position costs related to system  
33 updates required to carry of the provisions of this 2023 Act.

34 “**SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$7,843  
35 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of

1 expenses from federal funds collected or received by Oregon Health Authority to support  
2 position costs related to system updates required to carry out the provisions of this 2023 Act.

3 SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-  
4 ation made to the Department of Early Learning and Care by section 1 (1), chapter \_\_\_\_\_,  
5 Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5013), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for  
6 operations, is increased by \$1,830,240, for information technology system changes required  
7 to carry out the provisions of this 2023 Act.”
