

House Bill 2737

Sponsored by Representative SANCHEZ (at the request of Oregon Parks and Recreation Department) (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows agencies to sell, lease or donate state real property of agency to eligible Indian tribes notwithstanding ordinary transfer procedures.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transfers of state property.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 270.010 (2) or 270.100 to 270.190, a state agency may**
5 **transfer, convey, donate, exchange or lease to an eligible Indian tribe, as defined in ORS**
6 **307.181, any real property owned by the agency at such price and on such terms as the**
7 **agency may determine.**

8 **(2) Notwithstanding ORS 273.775 to 273.790, an agency disposing of real property under**
9 **this section also may convey the mineral and geothermal resource rights in the real property**
10 **to the Indian tribe.**
