House Bill 2803

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study nutritionist licensing. Directs authority to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health care not later than September 15, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to nutritionists.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Oregon Health Authority shall study the establishment of a licensure 5 program for nutritionists, with a focus on ensuring that the licensure facilitates health

6 insurer reimbursement for services provided by nutritionists and increases access to pro-

7 fessional nutritional advice for Oregonians. The authority shall submit a report in the man-

8 ner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim

- 9 committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care no later than September 15,
