## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires [Housing and Community Services Department to study] Department of Human Services to provide financial support to nonprofits to provide affordable housing for college students. [Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to affordable housing not later than September 15, 2024.] Appropriates moneys from General Fund to department for such purposes.

Sunsets January 2, 2026.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to affordable housing for college students.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Department of Human Services shall provide financial support to

5 nonprofit organizations providing affordable housing support to low-income college students

6 across this state in accordance with the department's self-sufficiency programs.

7 <u>SECTION 2.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

8 ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of

9 the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000 to provide financial support to nonprofit organ-

10 izations under section 1 of this 2023 Act.

11 SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2026.
