SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires [*Housing and Community Services Department to study*] **Department of Human Services to provide financial support to nonprofits to provide** affordable housing for college students. [*Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to affordable housing not later than September 15, 2024.*] **Appropriates moneys from General Fund to department for such purposes.**
Sunsets January 2, 2026.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to affordable housing for college students.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall provide financial support to**
5 **nonprofit organizations providing affordable housing support to low-income college students**
6 **across this state in accordance with the department's self-sufficiency programs.**

7 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
8 **ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of**
9 **the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000 to provide financial support to nonprofit organ-**
10 **izations under section 1 of this 2023 Act.**

11 **SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2026.**
