## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2929

1	In line 2 of the printed bill, delete "; amending ORS 537.781".
2	Delete lines 4 through 13 and insert:
3	"SECTION 1. If the Water Resources Department has information that a person has
4	engaged in any activity that is in violation of ORS 537.130, 537.535, 540.710 or 540.720, in ad-
5	dition to any other available remedies, the department may apply to the Circuit Court for
6	Marion County, or to the circuit court for any county in which the activity has occurred, for
7	a temporary or permanent injunction requiring the person to:
8	"(1) Refrain from the activity; and
9	"(2) Take any actions necessary to remedy the violation or any threat to water supplies
10	public health or public safety resulting from the violation.
11	"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2030.
12	"SECTION 3. (1) On or before September 15, 2028, the Water Resources Department shall
13	report, in the manner prescribed in ORS 192.245, to a committee or interim committee of the
14	Legislative Assembly related to water on the department's use of injunctive authority pur-
15	suant to section 1 of this 2023 Act.
16	"(2) The report must describe, but need not be limited to describing, the frequency of the
17	department's pursuit of injunctions pursuant to section 1 of this 2023 Act and the outcomes
18	of applying for, and being granted, injunctions pursuant to section 1 of this 2023 Act.
19	"SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2030.".
