## House Bill 2929

Sponsored by Representative MARSH (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Authorizes Water Resources Department to seek injunctive relief if person has engaged, or is about to engage, in activity that is or will be violation of certain water laws.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to the enforcement of water laws; amending ORS 537.781. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. ORS 537.781 is amended to read: 4 537.781. If the Water Resources Department has information that a person has engaged, or is 5 about to engage, in any activity that is or will be a violation of ORS 537.130, 537.535, 537.747, 6 7 537.753, 537.762, [or] 537.765, **540.710** or **540.720** or the standards described in ORS 537.780 (1)(b) or 8 (c), in addition to any other available remedies, the department may apply to the circuit court for Marion County, or to the circuit court for any county in which the activity has occurred or will occur, for a temporary or permanent injunction requiring the person to: 10 (1) Refrain from the activity; and 11 12 (2) Take any actions necessary to remedy the violation or any threat to groundwater supplies, 13 public health or public safety.
