

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3001

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete the first “and”.

2 In line 3, after “805.105” insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

3 In line 9, delete “(A)” and insert “(B)”.

4 In line 11, delete “(B)” and insert “(C)”.

5 On page 3, after line 29, insert:

6 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
7 expenditures established by section 2 (3), chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House
8 Bill 5040), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-
9 penses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal
10 funds received as reimbursement from the United States Department of Transportation, but
11 excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2 (3), chapter _____,
12 Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5040), collected or received by the Department of
13 Transportation, for project delivery and support, is increased by \$20,000.

14 “**SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
15 expenditures established by section 2 (5), chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House
16 Bill 5040), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-
17 penses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal
18 funds received as reimbursement from the United States Department of Transportation, but
19 excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2 (5), chapter _____,
20 Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5040), collected or received by the Department of
21 Transportation, for driver and motor vehicle services, is increased by \$5,000.

22 “**SECTION 6.** This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
23 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect
24 July 1, 2023.”
