SUMMARY

Removes suspension of requirement of showing proficiency in Essential Learning Skills as condition of earning diploma.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. Section 3, chapter 495, Oregon Laws 2021, is amended to read:
6	Sec. 3. Notwithstanding any rules adopted by the State Board of Education, a student may not
7	be required to show proficiency in Essential Learning Skills as a condition of receiving a high
8	school diploma during the 2021-2022[,] or 2022-2023 [or 2023-2024] school year.
9	SECTION 2. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect
11	on its passage.
