## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to nursing programs.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall establish a program to provide in-5 centives to increase the recruitment and retention of nurse instructors, including but not 6 limited to increasing the salary of nurse instructors in this state.

7 (2) The authority may adopt rules to carry out this section.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The Nursing Programs Salary Fund is established in the State Treasury, 9 separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Nursing Programs 10 Salary Fund shall be credited to the fund. The fund consists of moneys appropriated to the 11 fund by the Legislative Assembly and gifts, grants or other moneys contributed to the fund 12 by any source, whether public or private. Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated 13 to the Oregon Health Authority to carry out the provisions of section 1 of this 2023 Act.
