Requires Department of Transportation to study development of uniform standards for speed bump height and markings.
Sunsets January 2, 2025.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT 2 Relating to transportation. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall conduct a study of speed bumps to examine the possibility of developing uniform standards for speed bump height and speed 5 bump markings and shall make a report on its findings. 6 7 (2) The department shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative 8 Assembly related to transportation in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than 9 10 September 15, 2024. SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025. 11 12
