

House Bill 3416

Sponsored by Representatives SMITH G, MARSH, OWENS, GOMBERG

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to Oregon Business Development Department for distribution to recipients for industrial lands projects.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to industrial lands projects; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$24,500,000 for the department to distribute according to the following schedule to be used by each recipient only for the respective industrial lands project there set forth:

Amount	Recipient	Project
\$1,500,000	City of Depoe Bay	Docks and pilings improvements.
\$1,000,000	City of La Pine	Business Incubator located at the La Pine Industrial Park.
\$1,300,000	City of Monroe	Water infrastructure improvements.
\$2,200,000	City of Waldport	Sewer connections for industrial lands.
\$2,000,000	Independence State Airport	Water and sewer infrastructure improvements.
\$2,500,000	Harney County	Infrastructure improvements on industrial land within the City of Burns.
