

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3421

By COMMITTEE ON EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, GENERAL GOVERNMENT, AND
VETERANS

1 Delete lines 10 through 25 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, if circumstances exist that necessitate an
3 official ceremony or other event to be held on a day other than the legal holiday, the Director of
4 Veterans’ Affairs shall notify the presiding officers of each house of the Legislative Assembly of the
5 circumstances, at least 30 days prior to the legal holiday to the extent possible.

6 **“SECTION 2. (1) It is the expectation of the Legislative Assembly that all state-owned
7 and state-maintained veterans’ facilities, memorials for honoring veterans and war memo-
8 rials be in clean condition and good repair for Memorial Day, Veterans Day and any cere-
9 mony or other event that may be held to commemorate Memorial Day or Veterans Day.**

10 **“(2) The Director of Veterans’ Affairs shall communicate to all state agencies in advance
11 of every Memorial Day and Veterans Day the expectations described in subsection (1) of this
12 section.”.**
