In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro- $\mathbf{5}$ priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 6 1, 2023, out of the General Fund: 7 "(1) The amount of \$10,000,000, for deposit into the Housing and Community Services Department Revolving Account to provide grants to culturally responsive, culturally specific 8 9 or tribal organizations to provide down payment assistance. 10 "(2) The amount of \$25,000,000, for deposit into the Housing Finance Fund to provide 11 flexible loans to home purchasers. 12"SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-13 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,000,000, to provide grants to each of the 14 15nine federally recognized tribes in Oregon, to be used to support low-income individuals' 16 homeownership needs, including through down payment assistance, home purchasers' edu-17 cation and home repair programs. 18 "SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-19 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 20 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,800,000, to provide grants to up to 24 21culturally responsive or culturally specific organizations to expand homeownership services. 22"SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Bureau of Labor and Industries, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out 2324of the General Fund: 25"(1) The amount of \$2,400,000, to provide a grant to the Fair Housing Council of Oregon 26to support fair housing in this state. 27"(2) The amount of \$2,300,000, to support the bureau's housing discrimination investi-28gations and fair housing education and outreach. "SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-29priated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the 30 31 General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, to enforce fair housing laws.
