House Bill 3520

Sponsored by Representative BREESE-IVERSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs agencies of state government to revoke remote work arrangements that were put in place due to COVID-19 pandemic.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to termination of remote work arrangements; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, shall revoke 5 remote work arrangements that were put in place due to the declaration of a state of 6 emergency issued by the Governor on March 8, 2020, or any extensions of the declaration of

7 emergency.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect 10 on its passage.
