## A-Engrossed House Bill 5017

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Emergency Management for certain biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department. Limits certain biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Oregon Department of Emergency Management; and

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4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Oregon Department of Emergency Manage-

6 ment, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the following

7 amounts, for the following purposes:

8 (1) Administration...... \$ 17,541,872

9 (2) Preparedness and Response ..... \$ 3,957,006

10 (3) Mitigation and Recovery...... \$ 444,261

11 (4) Debt Service..... \$ 4,841,640

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Department of Emergency Management, for the following purposes:
