## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5019

1 Delete lines 4 through 15 of the printed bill and insert:

2 "<u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$7,386,826 for homelessness prevention services delivered through the Oregon Eviction Diversion and Prevention and Eviction Prevention Rapid Response programs.

<sup>7</sup> "<u>SECTION 2.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 9 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$26,213,174 for homelessness prevention 10 services delivered through the Oregon Eviction Diversion and Prevention and Eviction Pre-11 vention Rapid Response programs.

12 "<u>SECTION 3.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-13 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 14 30, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$200,000 for the development and design of 15 a statewide, long-term rent assistance program for individuals who are rehoused with state 16 investments made by sections 4 and 5 of this 2023 Act.

17 "<u>SECTION 4.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-18 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 19 30, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$20,900,000 to increase shelter capacity and 20 connections to shelter, support rapid rehousing initiatives, provide capacity support for cul-21 turally responsive organizations and provide sanitation services for communities in desig-22 nated homelessness emergency areas, based on local plans submitted to the department.

<sup>23</sup> "<u>SECTION 5.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-<sup>24</sup> priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July <sup>25</sup> 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$64,300,000 to increase shelter capacity and <sup>26</sup> connections to shelter, support rapid rehousing initiatives, provide capacity support for cul-<sup>27</sup> turally responsive organizations and provide sanitation services for communities in desig-<sup>28</sup> nated homelessness emergency areas, based on local plans submitted to the department.

29 "<u>SECTION 6.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-30 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 31 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000 to provide support to members of 32 federally recognized Indian tribes in Oregon experiencing homelessness.

33 "<u>SECTION 7.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro 34 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June
 35 30, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,125,824 for the administration of

homelessness prevention programs and local plans addressing unsheltered homelessness in
 designated homelessness emergency areas.

3 "<u>SECTION 8.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,145,303 for the administration of homelessness prevention programs and local plans addressing unsheltered homelessness in designated homelessness emergency areas.

8 "<u>SECTION 9.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-9 priated to the Oregon Department of Emergency Management, for the biennium ending June 10 30, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$923,925 for the coordination of efforts to 11 address homelessness in designated homelessness emergency areas as part of the activation 12 of the State of Oregon Emergency Operations Plan.

<sup>13</sup> "<u>SECTION 10.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-<sup>14</sup> priated to the Oregon Department of Emergency Management, for the biennium beginning <sup>15</sup> July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$722,631 for the coordination of efforts <sup>16</sup> to address homelessness in designated homelessness emergency areas as part of the acti-<sup>17</sup> vation of the State of Oregon Emergency Operations Plan.

<sup>18</sup> "<u>SECTION 11.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-<sup>19</sup> priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July <sup>20</sup> 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$26,135,000 to increase shelter capacity and <sup>21</sup> connections to shelter, support rapid rehousing initiatives, provide capacity support for cul-<sup>22</sup> turally responsive organizations and provide sanitation services for communities within the <sup>23</sup> OR-505 - Oregon Balance of State Continuum of Care.

24 "<u>SECTION 12.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-25 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 26 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,250,000 for the administration of support 27 provided to address homelessness in communities within the OR-505 - Oregon Balance of 28 State Continuum of Care.

29 "<u>SECTION 13.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-30 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 31 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000 for deposit into the Emergency 32 Housing Account created under ORS 458.620, for the purpose of providing services and as-33 sistance to school-aged children enrolled in kindergarten through grade 12 who are homeless 34 or at risk of becoming homeless, or their families.

<sup>35</sup> "<u>SECTION 14.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of <sup>36</sup> \$5,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for <sup>37</sup> payment of expenses by the Housing and Community Services Department from the Emer-<sup>38</sup> gency Housing Account created under ORS 458.620 for the purpose of providing services and <sup>39</sup> assistance to school-aged children enrolled in kindergarten through grade 12 who are <sup>40</sup> homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, or their families.

41 "SECTION 15. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-42 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 43 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$200,854, for administration of the provision 44 of services and assistance to school-aged children enrolled in kindergarten through grade 12 45 who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, or their families. <sup>1</sup> "<u>SECTION 16.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-<sup>2</sup> priated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out <sup>3</sup> of the General Fund, the amount of \$12,500,000 for the purpose of awarding grants to in-<sup>4</sup> crease access by youth experiencing homelessness to shelter facilities, outreach, culturally <sup>5</sup> specific services and mental health or substance abuse services and to strengthen partner-<sup>6</sup> ships with host home programs and other transitional housing options.

<sup>7</sup> "<u>SECTION 17.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,250,000 for the purpose of providing two-year grants to organizations operating host home projects to establish, continue or expand operation of host home projects for youth experiencing homelessness.

12 "<u>SECTION 18.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-13 priated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out 14 of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,171,469, for the administration of programs and ser-15 vices for youth experiencing homelessness.

"SECTION 19. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made to the Housing and Community Services Department by section 229, chapter 669,
Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, for distributions to compensate
landlords for unpaid rent payments pursuant to sections 12 and 13, chapter 420, Oregon Laws
2021, is decreased by \$16,623,741.

"<u>SECTION 20.</u> Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri ation made to the Housing and Community Services Department by section 1, chapter 556,
 Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, is decreased by \$14,000,000.

24 "<u>SECTION 21.</u> This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
25 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect
26 on its passage.".

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
