SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by State Mortuary and Cemetery Board, Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine, Occupational Therapy Licensing Board, Board of Medical Imaging, State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology and Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of specified boards; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 5 \$3,090,191 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 6 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, 7 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Mortuary 8 and Cemetery Board.

9 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 10 \$1,134,344 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 11 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, 12 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Board of 13 Naturopathic Medicine.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$727,306 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Occupational Therapy Licensing Board.

19 <u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 20 \$1,569,834 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 21 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, 22 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Board of Medical 23 Imaging.

24 <u>SECTION 5.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 25 \$1,255,280 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for

1 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,

2 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Board of

3 Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology.

4 <u>SECTION 6.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 5 \$1,617,303 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 6 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, 7 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon State

8 Veterinary Medical Examining Board.

9 <u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect

11 July 1, 2023.
