House Bill 5025

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Concurrent Resolution 23 (2023) (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures by commission from certain lottery moneys.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by commission for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by commission from federal funds for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by commission from timber tax funds for Community College Sup-

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$33,308,670 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for debt service on lottery bonds sold for the benefit of Oregon public universities.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$11,821,800 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for debt service on lottery bonds sold for the benefit of Oregon community colleges.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$56,565,871 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to the Outdoor School Education Fund.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$17,788,281 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission from lottery moneys allocated to the Sports Lottery Account.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$286,205,192 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for

payment of expenses from lottery moneys distributed from the Education Stability Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for Oregon Opportunity Grants.

<u>SECTION 7.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$80,532,265 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys distributed from the Education Stability Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for public university operations and student support.

SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds and funds described in sections 12 to 16 of this 2023 Act, collected or received by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the following purposes:

- (2) Debt service on outstanding general obligation bonds sold for the benefit of Oregon
 Health and Science University.. \$ 7,328,750

<u>SECTION 9.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$20,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission from American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and transferred to the commission for carrying out the provisions of sections 3 and 3a, chapter 28, Oregon Laws 2022.

SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$91,808,631 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission from American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services and transferred to the commission for carrying out the provisions of sections 9 and 11, chapter 28, Oregon Laws 2022.

<u>SECTION 11.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$135,748,840 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, excluding federal funds described in section 14 of this 2023 Act, collected or received by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for Higher Education Coordinating Commission programs and related grants.

SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$98,626 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission from the moneys received from

the Western Oregon Timber Severance Tax Fund and the Eastern Oregon Timber Severance Tax Fund for the Community College Support Fund.

SECTION 13. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, expenditures by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for debt service on general obligation bonds and certificates of participation issued for the benefit of public universities and Oregon Health and Science University and paid with resources received from the public universities and Oregon Health and Science University are not limited.

<u>SECTION 14.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, expenditures by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for payments to individuals, organizations or units of government from federal National Emergency Grants funds are not limited.

<u>SECTION 15.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, expenditures by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission for debt service on Build America Bonds sold for the benefit of public universities and community colleges are not limited.

<u>SECTION 16.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, expenditures by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission of moneys from the Tuition Protection Fund are not limited.

SECTION 17. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023.

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
