## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to transfer certain amounts from Tobacco Settlement Funds Account for certain purposes. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to transfers to the Tobacco Enforcement Fund under ORS 6 293.537, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall make the following trans-

7 fers from the Tobacco Settlement Funds Account for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023:
