House Bill 5043

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Concurrent Resolution 23 (2023) (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Water Resources Department for biennial expenses. Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain lottery moneys.

Limits biennial expenditures for certain purposes from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and specified federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from other federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Water Resources Department; and declaring an

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4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Water Resources Department, for the 6 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the 7 following purposes:

- 8 (1) Administrative services \$ 10,259,906
- 9 (2) Field services \$ 19,733,022

10 (3) Water rights and

11 adjudications \$ 5,190,563

12 (4) Technical services..... \$ 15,197,290

13 (5) Director's office \$ 13,669,763

14 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 15 \$15,073,140 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 16 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-17 nomic Development Fund to the Water Resources Department for debt service.

18 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment 19 20 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and in-21cluding federal funds received under cooperative agreements with or contracts from the 22Bureau of Reclamation of the United States Department of the Interior, the United States 23Army Corps of Engineers, the United States Geological Survey, the Bonneville Power Administration and the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, but excluding lottery funds and 24 federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the Water Resources 25 Department, for the following purposes: 26

15 <u>SECTION 5.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 16 \$6,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 17 payment of expenses by the Water Resources Department from American Rescue Plan Act 18 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys for a grant to Umatilla County for the 19 Ordnance Regional Water Infrastructure Project.

SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$800,000
is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of
expenses by the Water Resources Department from American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus
State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys for place-based planning.

24 <u>SECTION 7.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 25 \$1,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 26 payment of expenses by the Water Resources Department from the Water Well Abandon-27 ment, Repair and Replacement Fund established in ORS 537.766.

SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$500,000
is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of
expenses by the Water Resources Department from American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus
State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys for assistance to local governments with meeting fish
passage requirements for dam upgrade projects.

<u>SECTION 9.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$1,500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Water Resources Department from American Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys to supplement fee-based services pending development of sustainable, long-term funding mechanisms.

38 <u>SECTION 10.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 39 \$2,500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 40 payment of expenses by the Water Resources Department from American Rescue Plan Act 41 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys for the provision of contracted services to 42 perform flood methodology and inundation assessments for dams and engineering analyses 43 on dams.

44 <u>SECTION 11.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 45 \$2,600,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for

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- 1 payment of expenses by the Water Resources Department from American Rescue Plan Act
- 2 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys for the purchase and deployment of surface
- 3 and ground water data collection equipment.

4 <u>SECTION 12.</u> This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 5 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect 6 July 1, 2023.

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
