Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

That we, the members of the Eighty-second Legislative Assembly, recognize and honor the Indian community as an integral part of our shared journey and extend our heartfelt congratulations and support for the ongoing celebrations of India's independence.
