## **House Concurrent Resolution 13**

Sponsored by Representative HIEB

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Recognizes and honors Specialist Four Michael Lee Wilkins (1947-1969) for his service to his country.

2	Whereas Specialist Four Michael Lee Wilkins was born on January 22, 1947, in Portland,
3	Oregon; and
4	Whereas Specialist Four Wilkins attended Glenfair Elementary School and Reynolds High
5	School; and
6	Whereas Specialist Four Wilkins was drafted and entered the United States Army through the
7	Selective Service from Multnomah County, Oregon; and
8	Whereas Specialist Four Wilkins began his tour of duty in Vietnam on August 25, 1968; and
9	Whereas Specialist Four Wilkins was attached to the 11th Light Infantry Brigade, 3rd Battalion,
10	1st Infantry, D Company; and
11	Whereas on March 29, 1969, near Landing Zone Bronco, Quang Ngai Province, South Vietnam,
12	Specialist Four Wilkins perished from wounds received in a hostile action; and
13	Whereas Specialist Four Wilkins was awarded the Bronze Star, Silver Star, Purple Heart, Com-
14	bat Infantryman Badge, Marksmanship Badge, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign
15	Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Army Presidential Unit Citation, Vietnamese Gallantry Cross and
16	Army Good Conduct Medal; and
17	Whereas Specialist Four Wilkins was laid to rest in Willamette National Cemetery and is hon-
18	ored on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C.; and
19	Whereas Specialist Four Wilkins served his country with honor and distinction; now, therefore,
20	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
21	That we, the members of the Eighty-second Legislative Assembly, recognize and honor Specialist
22	Four Michael Lee Wilkins for his service to his country.
