House Joint Resolution 28

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution prohibiting death penalty. Refers proposed amendment to people for their approval or rejection at next regular general election.

JOINT RESOLUTION 1 2 Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon: PARAGRAPH 1. Section 40, Article I of the Constitution of the State of Oregon, is amended 3 to read: 4 5 Sec. 40. A sentence of death may not be imposed or executed. [Notwithstanding sections 6 15 and 16 of this Article, the penalty for aggravated murder as defined by law shall be death upon 7 unanimous affirmative jury findings as provided by law and otherwise shall be life imprisonment with 8 minimum sentence as provided by law.] 9 10 PARAGRAPH 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the 11 people for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election held throughout 12 this state. 13
