SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Secretary of State to study how to improve transparency and accountability in conduct of campaigns by candidates for elected public office. Directs secretary to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to elections not later than September 15, 2024.

Relating to political campaigns.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall study how to improve transparency and accountability in the conduct of campaigns by candidates for elected public office. The secretary shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to elections no later than September 15, 2024.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
