## Senate Bill 531

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for summer and afterschool programs.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

2	Relating to funding for programs offered during nonschool hours; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri
5	ated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the
6	General Fund, the amount of \$, which shall be expended for summer and after-schoo
7	programs, with priority given to applicants or programs that, as determined by the depart
8	ment:
9	(1) Serve youth from rural areas or historically underserved populations, including youth
10	with disabilities;
11	(2) Encourage collaboration between community organizations and education providers;
12	(3) Promote the healthy development of youth;
13	(4) Use or expand upon existing programs, organizations or services provided to youth
14	or for the benefit of youth; and
15	(5) Align with quality standards established by the department in consultation with pri
16	vate and public organizations and community members involved with expanded learning op
17	portunities.
18	SECTION 2. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
19	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effec
20	July 1, 2023.
