On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "theft" delete the rest of the line and insert a period. 1 2 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert: "SECTION 1. (1) The Organized Retail Theft Grant Program is established to assist: 3 "(a) Cities and counties with the costs incurred by local law enforcement agencies in 4 $\mathbf{5}$ addressing organized retail theft; 6 "(b) The Department of State Police with costs incurred by the department in addressing 7 organized retail theft; and "(c) Community-based organizations in addressing organized retail theft. 8 9 "(2) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall administer the grant program de-10 scribed in subsection (1) of this section and shall award the grants described in this section. "(3) The commission shall adopt rules to administer the grant program. Rules adopted 11 12under this section must include: 13"(a) A methodology for reviewing and approving grant applications and awarding grants; 14 and 15"(b) A process for evaluating the efficacy of programs and services funded by the grant 16 program. 17 "(4) Moneys distributed to grant recipients under this section must be spent on costs 18 associated with addressing and prosecuting organized retail theft. 19 "(5) The commission shall establish three categories of grants under this section as fol-20 lows: 21"(a) Grants awarded, on a competitive basis, to cities and counties; (b) Grants awarded, on a competitive basis, to community-based organizations; and 22"(c) Grants awarded to the department. 23 24"SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-25priated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for the purposes of the grant program 2627described in section 1 of this 2023 Act.". 28
