

# Senate Bill 100

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Human Services, Mental Health and Recovery)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Human Services to study department's regulatory oversight of long term care facilities. Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health not later than September 15, 2024.  
Sunsets January 2, 2025.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to long term care.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall study the department's regulatory**  
5 **oversight of long term care facilities. The department shall submit a report in the manner**  
6 **provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation to improve the**  
7 **department's regulatory oversight or reduce administrative burdens on long term care fa-**  
8 **cilities, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health no later than**  
9 **September 15, 2024.**

10 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.**
