SUMMARY

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to Umpqua Fishery Enhancement Derby to [conduct fish] facilitate salmonid habitat restoration projects [at specified locations].

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
5	ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July
6	1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,400,000, for distribution to Umpqua Fishery
7	Enhancement Derby to facilitate restoration projects to mitigate the impacts of sediment
8	and salmonid habitat loss on the lower Rogue River.
9	SECTION 2. This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2023
10	regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
