## A-Engrossed Senate Bill 200

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to Salvage Chief (LSM380) Foundation for purpose of repairing and upgrading salvage vessel.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri
5	ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July
6	1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000, to be distributed by grant to the
7	Salvage Chief (LSM380) Foundation, an Oregon public benefit corporation, for the purpose
8	of repairing, upgrading and returning to operation the vessel known as the Salvage Chief
9	as follows:
10	(1) \$1,894,737 for hull repairs;
11	(2) \$631,579 for engine and fire pump upgrades; and
12	(3) \$473,684 for emergency communications upgrades, United States Coast Guard in
13	spection and contingency.
14	SECTION 2. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
15	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect
16	July 1, 2023.
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
