Provides that legislative department may not call on state police to enforce criminal laws or regulations of department.

2 Relating to the state police; amending ORS 181A.090.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 181A.090 is amended to read:

5 181A.090. The state police, with the approval of the Governor, may be called upon by [any other

6 branch or department of the state government] the executive department, as defined in ORS

174.112, or the judicial department, as defined in ORS 174.113, to enforce criminal laws or any
regulation of such branch or department.
