

# Senate Bill 24

Sponsored by Senator BOQUIST (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that legislative department may not call on state police to enforce criminal laws or regulations of department.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the state police; amending ORS 181A.090.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 181A.090 is amended to read:

5 181A.090. The state police, with the approval of the Governor, may be called upon by [*any other*  
6 *branch or department of the state government*] **the executive department, as defined in ORS**  
7 **174.112, or the judicial department, as defined in ORS 174.113**, to enforce criminal laws or any  
8 regulation of such branch or department.
